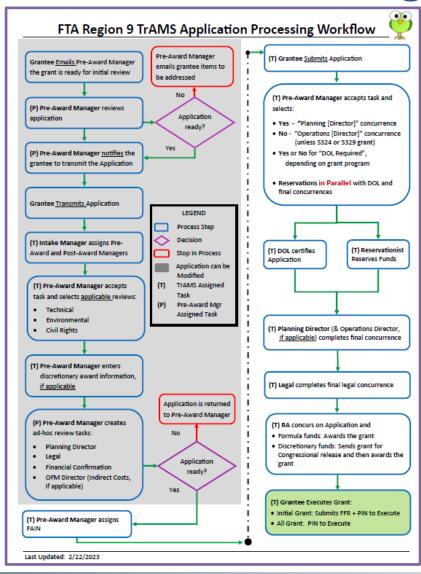

Frequently Encountered Issues (Application Summary)

- 1. Application Title/Name
- 2. Special Provisions for Executive Summary
- 3. Period of Performance
- 4. Indirect Cost

Frequently Encountered Issues (Project Level)

- Planning/Project Plan Documents (i.e., Statewide Transportation Improvement Plan or STIP)
- 2. Project Benefits
- 3. Environmental Determination

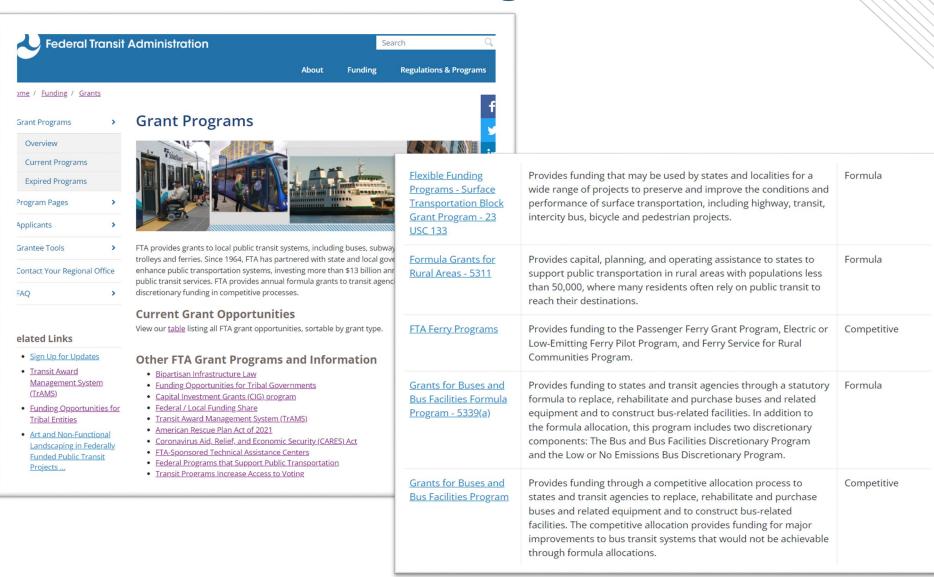
Frequently Encountered Issues (Activity Level)

- 2. Match Ratio and Calculation
- 3. Adjustment Amount
- 4. Scope Code
- 5. ALI Code
- 6. Useful Life Information

- 8. 1% Security Expenditure and 0.75% Safety Expenditure
- 9. Milestones (for Construction and Procurement)

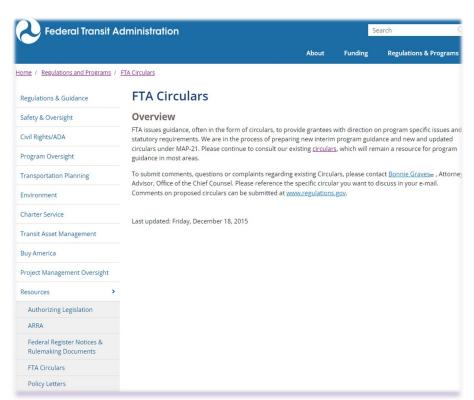

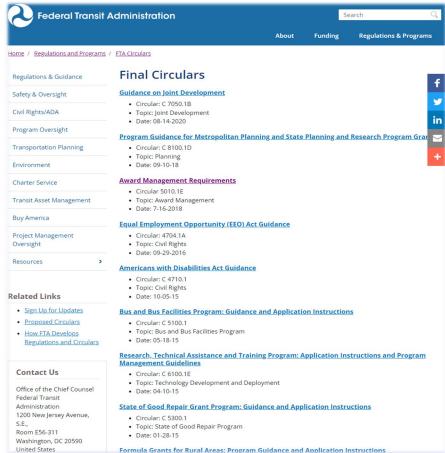
