Team Admin and Learners


Team Admins are typically Transit Agency Managers

- Add/Delete Learners to the Agency's Team
- Access Reports (Transcripts)
- Manage Curricula Assign or unassign courses
 - Can be done by job title or responsibilities


Leaners

- Follow a learning track or explore at your own pace




