




MESA HISTORICAL CONTEXT







2018-2019

- 1.2 MM budget
- 8 properties funded



EDI GRANT – FAÇADE IMPROVEMENT


- Congressionally directed spending of \$300,000 for façade improvement
- Mesa is providing a \$300,000 match
- Program is in development
 - Funds must be obligated by September 2025
 - Funds must be expended by March 2030



DOWNTOWN FAÇADE IMPROVEMENT




OVERVIEW OF DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS
